Participants who speak the words of the Torah blessings must be Jewish, 13 years of age or older (for an individual aliyah.) Grandparents are usually given the first aliyah, and parents, the last aliyah. Groups, such as uncles, cousins, friends, may be called together. It is customary for Jewish adults to wear kippot and tallitot when called for an Aliyah to the Torah. Please list relationship to Bar/Bat Mitzvah.
