CANTOR JUVAL PORAT TEMPLE BETH SHOLOM - MIAMI BEACH, FL

Cantor Juval Porat grew up both in Israel and Germany during his formative years and beyond. In Israel, he studied at the B'nai Akiva Yeshiva. In Germany, he earned a Masters degree in Architecture, working in Berlin as an architect.

While in Architecture school, he served as a cantorial soloist at several congregations. The passion for singing and service leadership bred by those experiences led him to pursue cantorial studies at the newly established Institute of Cantorial Arts in Berlin, part of the Abraham Geiger College. His final academic year was spent at the Hebrew Union College in Jerusalem and in June 2009, he was invested as the first Reform cantor to be trained in Germany since World War II. Cantor Juval Porat comes to us from Beth Chayim Chadashim, the world's first synagogue founded by and for the LGBTQIA+ community in Los Angeles. Some of his professional highlights include being clergy-in-residence for several missions to Israel by A Wider Bridge; serving as Programming Committee Chair for the 2018 ACC (American Conference of Cantors)/GTM (Guild of Temple Musicians) Convention in Dallas, Texas; attending and leading a workshop at Eighteen: 22 | A global Network for Change Conference in Salzburg, Austria; and speaking on LGBT Liturgy and service leader at Congregation Shirah Chadashah in Melbourne, Australia. Additionally, he is serving the American Conference of Cantors Juval Porat is pursuing the path of becoming a certified counselor of Non-Violent Communication (also known as Compassionate Communication) based on the writings of Marshall Rosenberg and his interests in the intersection of Jewish mindfulness and NVC.

In addition to being a Reform Jewish clergy, his passions include mental health, yoga, animal welfare, veganism and living sustainably in ways that ensure a healthy planet for future generations. He joined Temple Beth Sholom as our Senior Cantor on June 1, 2023. Cantor Porat is humbled to serve the spiritual needs of this congregation in partnership with TBS Clergy and lay leaders.

CANTOR DONNA AZU TEMPLE SHALOM - NAPLES, FL

Originally from Southern California, Cantor Donna Azu received a Bachelor of Music degree in Opera Performance and Music Education from the California State University of Long Beach. Prior to attending the Debbie Friedman School of Sacred Music at Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion (HUC-JIR), she earned a teaching credential in music and taught music and theater. In addition, she sang professionally with Opera Pacific, Long Beach Opera, and the Los Angeles Jewish Symphony.

CANTOR NORMAN COHEN FALAH TEMPLE SINAI - NORTH MIAMI BEACH, FL

Cantor Norman Cohen Falah was born in Buenos Aires, Argentina, the son of an Ashkenazi mother and a Sephardic father. Both these traditions bore a strong influence on his upbringing, inspiring him to pursue a lifelong celebration of the two cultures. After serving as Hazzan in Argentina for eight years, Norman moved to the Netherlands as full-time Chazan at the Liberal Jewish Community in Amsterdam, followed by a full-time Cantor position at Belsize Square Synagogue in London. A versatile, soulful, and energetic performer, Cantor Norman Cohen Falah sings in seven languages, in a variety of styles and for all ages. As a composer, Cantor Norman Cohen Falah has written many songs and liturgical compositions, mostly in his native Spanish.

CANTOR TIFANI COYOT TEMPLE BETH AM - PINECREST, FL

Cantor Tifani Coyot is a worship leader, performer, and educator who fosters relationships and community through meaningful Jewish experiences that unite the body, soul, and mind. Notably, she holds certification as an eating disorder recovery coach and conducts lectures and workshops to advocate for prevention and healing related to body/soul image and disordered eating.
